If you're volunteering at the After School Academy in East Palo Alto, you're helping to improve student achievement by inspiring creativity, promoting team work, and providing a fun, safe, and supportive place for students to learn after school. Now, I don't know about you, but that sounds all right to me!

The After School Academy offers tutoring, homework help,

and academic enrichment, which focuses on student and academic results. Brian Scoles, the Assistant Director of After School Academy, says, "On a given day, we have two to six high school-aged volunteers coming in to read with students, help them with homework, and help them with California State test preparation - these are all important parts of our curriculum." The volunteers work in classrooms with Kindergarten through fifth-grade students.

Brian says, "The students love to have high-school aged youth as role models and tutors, and the volunteers have lots of fun helping out. I often have youth volunteers recommend the program to their friends, who then come in, and then they invite more friends - that's always a good sign that everyone's enjoying their time here."
